## 1. SYLLABUS OUTLINE

In the Nonverbal Reasoning paper, students are expected to demonstrate pattern recognition, logical thinking, and visual problem-solving skills. The questions are designed to assess innate reasoning ability and do not require prior subject knowledge or curriculum-based learning.

Students will be presented with a variety of visual puzzles involving shapes, sequences, spatial patterns, and relationships between figures. These tasks test their ability to observe, compare, and deduce patterns based purely on visual input.

• Nature of Questions: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)



1. Select a figure from amongst the Answer Figures which will continue the same series as established by the five Problem Figures.






2. Establish a similar relationship between figures C and D by selecting a suitable figure from the Answer Set that would replace the question mark (?) in fig. (D).


