- **Number of Questions:** Section A (10 marks) + Section B (5 marks) + Section C (10 marks)
- **Duration:** 40 minutes

A) Reading Comprehension

- Read unseen passages and answer factual and inferential questions.
- Practice skimming and scanning techniques.
- Focus on identifying meanings, main idea, and supporting details.

- Article Writing: Discuss a topic logically and clearly, often with an opinion or suggestion.
