1. SYLLABUS OUTLINE

2. QUESTION PAPER PATTERN

- Nature of Questions: Short answers and one essay
- Number of Questions: Section A (10 marks) + Section B (5 marks) + Section C (10 marks)
- **Duration:** 40 minutes

Section A

A) Reading Comprehension

- Read unseen passages and answer factual and inferential questions.
- Practice skimming and scanning techniques.
- Focus on identifying meanings, main idea, and supporting details.
- Focus on identifying basic stylistic devices
- Resource: Passage 1, Passage 2

B) Vocabulary

- Synonyms
- Derive word meanings from context
- Resource: <u>Dictionary.com</u>, <u>BBC</u>

Section B

C) Grammar

- Tenses (Present, Past, Future)
- Prepositions
- Transformation of Sentences
- Direct and Indirect Speech
- Active and Passive Voice

Section C

D) Composition

- Narrative Writing: Tell a story with a clear beginning, middle and end.
- Article Writing: Discuss a topic logically and clearly, often with an opinion or suggestion.
- Resource: <u>BBC (Article)</u>, <u>BBC (Narrative Writing)</u>
- Preparation Tips:
 - o Practice brainstorming ideas before writing.
 - o Focus on structure: introduction, body, conclusion.
 - Use a range of vocabulary and varied sentence structures.
 - o Proofread for grammar and spelling errors.
