#### Grade 9 & below

28<sup>th</sup> Jan to 5<sup>th</sup> Feb 2026- Cricket (Boys)

3<sup>rd</sup> Feb to 5<sup>th</sup> Feb 2026 - Football, Basketball, Hockey, Volleyball, Tennis, Badminton, Table Tennis (Boys &Girls)

#### Grade 6 & below

10<sup>th</sup> Feb to 12<sup>th</sup> Feb 2026-Basketball, Badminton, Table tennis, Tennis, Football (Boys), Hockey (Mixed group boys & girls) Football (Mixed group boys & girls)

11<sup>th</sup> Feb to 18<sup>th</sup> Feb 2026-Cricket-(Boys)

### Format of the tournament:

League cum Knock out tournament

We can accommodate 12 teams on first cum first served basis, Cricket we can accommodate 8 teams on first cum first served basis.

**Entry Fees:** Cricket – INR 5000/+ Platform Charges - Per team.

Other games & sports INR 2500/ + Platform Charges - Per team.

### **Rules & Regulations:**

- Students studying in grade 9 & below / grade 6 & below are eligible to play.
- It is mandatory for schools to register online.
- Student school IDs should be available on all days of participation. This is mandatory.
- Registration forms once submitted cannot be altered and only those students mentioned in the form will be allowed to participate in that sport.
- All teams should report 30minutes prior to the match time.
- Team not taking the field or court for 15 minutes beyond the start of play will forfeit the match, and the opposite team will proceed to the next round.
- The decision of the organizing committee will be final in all regards.
- Chief referee /organizer at their discretion may postpone/alter time of a match due to unavoidable circumstances.
- In matters of doubt not covered by the tournament rules, the decision of the tournament committee will be final and binding upon all matters concerned.
- Any request for postponement or change of match timings will not be entertained.
- Schools are requested to avoid common players in two games as far as possible, so that all
  matches can be held without any delay. No matches will be held for the players who are
  participating in other games.
- The responsibility of conduct and behavior of the student lies with the respective school teachers or coaches. Other than the participants and teachers, no one is allowed on campus. All school rules of TISB must be adhered to, and any failure to do this may result in immediate disqualification from the tournament, as determined by the Principal of TISB, whose decision on any disciplinary matter is final.

- The rules and fixtures of the tournament will be uploaded in the sports portal closer to the tournament date.
- Kindly make your own transport and food arrangements. Lunch will be provided only to the managers and Coaches.
- Players must be properly attired as per the regulations of the game. Teams/Players who are not properly attired may be debarred.
- Please take note that a team's participation in the competition is only confirmed after the registration fee has been paid online.
